

# CSR Report : December, 2025



# Health & Hygiene

- Co-organised medical camp in association with Lal Das Babu Sevak sangh and Sharanam Hospital at Ambedkar Bhavan, Dholka.
- Girl students from Utaraj, Aasta, Mothiya, Alva, Kalam and Baadodara villages studying in class 6 to 9 visited Kaka- Ba hospital and got acquainted with the health, education and skill development activities undertaken by Kaka Ba hospital
- Organised three multipurpose event in Mota Chhapra, Bhat and Kasindra villages. focusing Health check ups , documents for various government schemes, and menstrual hygiene. Total 162 members benefited. Diabetes and BP Check-ups- 25, ABHA and AAYUSHMAN card- 35, HB Screening- 35, Government schemes and health schemes- 45 members
- Carried health check up of Anganwadi kids in Utaraj in presence of SDM
- Anemic women and girls provided third month dose of Iron and folic acid tablets in Kalam village
- Organised eye check up camp at Hirapur Gram Panchayat in association with Bareja eye hospital, Total 45 villagers benefitted. Provided eyeglasses to 18 members and four members referred to hospital for various treatments.
- Organized awareness programme on No Tobacco Day at Bhat village on 31<sup>st</sup> May
- Organized Five medical camps at Bhat, Hirapur, Bhetawada, ward-9 and Virdi villages in collaboration with Health & Care Foundation, Ahmedabad. Total **520+** patients benefited. Also referred **74** patients to CHC/ Government hospitals for proper diagnosis/ treatment
- Conducted medical camps at Bhetawada and Virdi villages in collaboration with Health & Care Foundation, Ahmedabad. Total 145 community members benefited. Performed blood sugar tests for 40 members and patient requiring further treatment referred to CHC/ government hospitals
- Conducted medical camps at Nesda and Pisawada villages in association with Health and Care Foundation and SEWA-SSK, Total **232** nos villagers benefited from the camp
- Supported Jammu & Kashmir flood affected people with medicines and essential commodities through CSIR-IIIM, Jammu and local NGO.
- Supported Padyatri Seva Camp on Ambaji Highway with medicines to Pilgrims (Padyatris) walking to Ambaji from across Gujarat. Home Minister, Gujarat and senior officials visited the camp. **70,000+** Devotees availed services during the camp
- Organised eye medical camp with support from the Asian Paints; total 298 patients benefited. 98 patients diagnosed with cataract, PCO, Ptergium etc. will be treated at Kaka Ba on priority. 132 Nos of eye glasses also provided

# Education

- Meeting with school drop out girls and their parents and convinced them for enrolment in school in ned academic year
- Training on various courses is going on at Kaka Ba skill center with 60 students: Sewing-15, Computer –33, Nursing Course–12.
- Supported *Shala Praveshotsav* programme with 1600 school kits in Ahmedabad, Bharuch and Mehsana districts. Also participated in the school kit distribution ceremony at Bhat, Kasindra and Mota Chhapra villages. Shala Praveshotsav is a statewide mass enrollment drive in standard 1<sup>st</sup> initiated by Shri Narendra Modi, then, CM of Gujarat in 2011 to ensure 100% enrollment in standard 1<sup>st</sup>
- Door to door survey to identify eligible left out members in the village for AADHAR card, PM JAY card, Old age pension, Widow pension etc. is going on in Bhat, Kasindra and Mota Chhapra villages
- Survey for government documents viz. PM JY Card, Widow pension, Old Age Pension etc. is ongoing for eligible left out members in the villages
- Issued 475 Health Passports by SSK for online access of health detail/docs for Community members in adopted villages around Bhat, Dholka and Hansot

# Environment

- Celebrated World Environment Day on 5<sup>th</sup> June at Bhat village. Planted 30 saplings in Bhat Sub Centre
- Carried plantation at Ranoda primary school premises , 165 saplings
- Planted 200+ saplings in two schools- Ranoda and Khanpur in Dholka
- Conducted tree plantation drives at different schools, PHCs, Government hospitals and community places in Hansot block. Total 1260 saplings planted in collaboration with Range Forest office, Hansot; Gram Panchayats and local NGOs
- Supported Bhetawada Primary school with 105 nos of saplings to promote *Ek ped maa ke naam* and '*Mission Green School*' campaigns.
- Planted **1800+** saplings at CPL, Dholka, Kaka Ba, Shera, Mothiya, Digas, Mangrol, Rayama villages and other public places and school premises.
- Had meeting with Taluk Prathmik education Officer (TPEO), Dholka, CRC and Principles for tree plantation in 53 schools of Dholka taluka. Total **5500+** shrubs to be planted in during August- 2025
- Planted **1100** saplings in adopted villages around Bhat and Dholka through SEWA-SSK Team

## Agri & Animal Husbandry

Organised Farmer's meet at Bhetawada in Association with Gujbee to educate farmers for honey bee keeping activity

- Organised 2<sup>nd</sup> farmers' meet at Kaka Ba Hospital on 13<sup>th</sup> May in association with Gujbee, an Indian State Government Cooperative Society and educated farmers for honey bee keeping activity as additional livelihood option along with the agriculture; 30+ farmers from Hansot and surrounding villages participated. Training and visit of Honey bee farm is under planning

- Organized a seminar at Indrashil-Shantivan on Kharif crops during monsoon season in association with Arvind Foundation and TCL Agro division. 50+ women from villages near Sanand and Bavala participated. Also connected Agro team to an agro expert for meeting with farmers in Dholka taluka

- Arranged exposure visit of Aranej Krishi Vigyan Kendra with women from Nesda village, Imparted knowledge on reasonable use of pesticides and fertilizers

- Co-Organised cattle camp at Transad village in collaborator with Animal Husbandry Department, Ahmedabad, [221](#) Animal treated during the camp

- Conducted mass deworming drive in Kalam village, 172 animals provided deworming tablets and necessary medicines

## Livelihoodood

- Initiated Project SAVADH (Safety Actions for, Vehicles, Animals and Drivers on Highway ) aiming at road safety in Dholka and Bhat. [500+](#) reflector tapes and belts placed on animals in Dholka and nearby villages. This initiative will continue till the end of monsoon for animals and vehicles, especially tractors and two wheelers without break lights or reflectors. Veterinary dept. and other NGOs have also joined this initiative
